## Oil Level Check: Denso 7SBH17C Style Compressors gpd #6513151

## PLEASE NOTE:

All gpd 65 series compressors are equipped with the correct amount of oil.\* To verify the quantity of oil inside the compressor, refer to the tag attached to the gpd compressor. \*Unless otherwise noted.

The oil drain plug on the Denso 7SBH17C style compressors (gpd #6513151) is located in a different position than traditional compressors. Facing the compressor clutch forward, the oil plug is located near the top front of the compressor mount.

To check the oil level on this compressor, take out the oil plug bolt and empty the oil into a measuring device. Due to the internal design of this compressor, completely draining the oil will take a fair amount of time.

Don't forget to reinstall the O-ring and copper washer.
